Everything you need to get the most of your day at the Show



Disabled visitors and visitors with prams

The Show covers a wide area that is split into three sections divided by two main roads. These are connected by either temporary bridge or pedestrian crossing. Avoiding the bridge is possible for those who need to by obtaining a coloured wristband from security guards stationed at Gate A, C, H or E.

There is easy access to Ocean Hall via ramps for wheelchair and pram users. The Marina is controlled for safety reasons so unfortunately those using wheelchairs, or with assistance dogs, may experience delays in getting onto the Marina when crowded. Security guards are located at the entry and exit points of the Marina and will help with any assistance or questions.



Information Points

Information Points can be found at the Show Entrance. Our information hosts can be found throughout the Show and will be able to assist you with any questions you may have.



First Aid

The Show's Medical Centre is located in the Mayflower Park area at Gate E. If you require medical assistance, please contact a member of the security team or an information host who will be able to assist you.



Cash facility

Cash point and foreign exchange facilities are provided by International Currency Exchange and located in the Holiday Inn area.



General parking

Southampton city centre hosts 10,000 parking spaces in both public and privately owned car parks. The closest parking to the Show can be found at Westquay Multi Storey, Ocean Village and Leisure World pay and display.



Lost property

There are no cloakrooms or left luggage facilities at the Show. All lost property should be handed in to the Organiser's Office or security located beside Gate H in the Holiday Inn area.



Meeting point

The designated Meeting Point for the Show is under the entrance canopy of the Holiday Inn Hotel. This is an ideal place to arrange to meet your party if you become separated.



Toilets

Every area of the Show has toilet facilities that include disabled units. In Mayflower Park, there is a dedicated free baby care unit for Show visitors.
